SOQS will not be held in its usual format this year; there will be virtual quilt displays and exhibits available to watch through SOQS's social media sites and on the website. The good news is that Sarah Fielke will be returning to SOQS next year, and will be our SOQS Sunday presenter for 2021. Will you still be having the SOQS Quilt Raffle this year? Yes, the SOQS Raffle will still take place. Raffle tickets are available on our website, and the raffle will take place live at 4:00 pm PST on Saturday, July 11, 2020. Make sure to buy your tickets now!

We are so excited that we will be able to have our WISH Fabric Postcards available on our website for purchase; our Quilters Affair teacher cards will be available for online auction. Thanks to Free Spirit fabrics, we are going to be able to include the QBC in this year's activities. We will be featuring these blocks on our social media accounts and website; we are excited to see everyone's blocks!

We currently have our director Dawn, along with 2-3 volunteers to do everything from answering calls to sending newsletters and updating the website and social media accounts – along with working on all of the details for the “reimagined” show.
